Assistant Teen Center Director Stauffer discussed the Warren Township Teen Center’s proposed **Safe Space Program**. **Safe Space** programs increase the visible presence of student and adult allies who can help to shape a school culture that is accepting of all people, regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity/expression, or any other difference. For many students, the presence of allies to whom they can turn for support—or even the simple knowledge that allies exist—can be a big factor in developing a positive sense of self, building community, coping with bias, and working to improve school climate. With Board approval, we will be running pilot programs at both the campus and Park City teen centers.

They will be open to all and focused on diversity. After a brief discussion, the Board fully approved of the program and asked to be kept up to date on its progress.
